




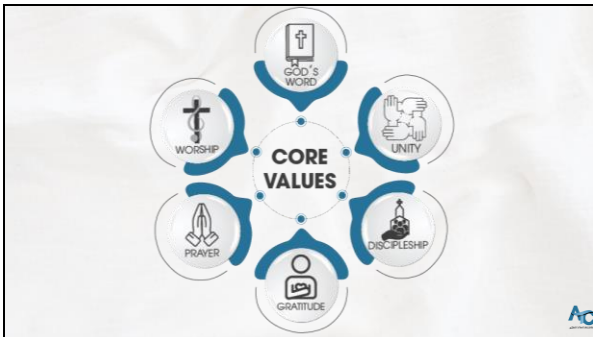
MISSION STATEMENT

Visitation Guidelines and Practices

To ensure your visit to Western Michigan Adult & Teen Challenge is a positive and uplifting experience for everyone, we ask that you follow these guidelines:

- Visits are held on **Saturdays only** unless special permission is granted by the Supervisor.
- **Prohibited items** include drugs, alcohol, tobacco products (including pipes and e-cigarettes), and electronic devices (cell phones, radios, tablets, etc.). Visitors' phones must remain in their vehicle during the visit. Students are not allowed to **chew gum, use cell phones, or leave the premises** with visitors, including walking visitors to the parking lot, without the Supervisor's approval.
- **Behavioral expectations**
 - Visitors under the influence of drugs or alcohol are not allowed on the property.
 - Public displays of affection are limited to an initial and closing hug or kiss.
 - Vulgar or profane language is not permitted.
 - Visiting in vehicles is not allowed.
- **Food policy:** All permissible food must be eaten during the visit. Leftovers must be taken home by the visitor. Food donations must go through the Kitchen Supervisor.
- **Items for students:** All items, including mail, stamps, money, music, bracelets, or other miscellaneous items, must be approved by staff before being given to the student.
- **Photography and music:** Taking photos of students is not permitted, as they are only authorized photos for program use. Tablets, instruments, and music players are also not allowed.
- Students and visitors are not allowed to exchange unauthorized mail or make unapproved phone calls.
